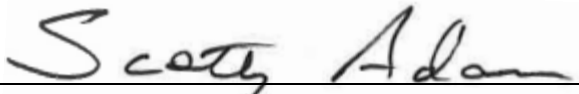

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX LEVIES FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR FOR HANCOCK COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The Hancock County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on its proposed budget and proposed tax levies for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 on September 6, 2022 at 2:00p.m. at the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room at 854 Highway 90, Bay Saint Louis, Mississippi 39520.

The Hancock County Board of Supervisors is now operating with projected total budget revenue of \$76,683,820.00 with (34%) or \$26,370,230.00 of such revenue obtained through ad valorem taxes. For the next fiscal year, the proposed budget has total projected revenue of \$63,641,338.00. Of that amount, (43%) or \$27,060,206.00, is proposed to be financed through total ad valorem tax levy.

The Hancock County Board of Supervisor has decided not to increase the ad valorem tax millage rate for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 above the current fiscal year's ad valorem tax millage rate. This means you will not pay more in ad valorem taxes on your home, automobile tag, utilities, business fixtures and equipment and rental real property, unless the assessed value of your property has increased for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

Any citizen of Hancock County, Mississippi is invited to attend this public hearing on the proposed budget and tax levies for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 and will be allowed to speak for a reasonable amount of time and offer tangible evidence before any vote is taken.

It is the intent of the Hancock County Board of Supervisors to recess this September 6, 2022 public hearing until September 14, 2022 at 3:30p.m. in order to Adopt the Budget and Set the Tax Levies for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
